




African Swine Fever: What Is It?

- HIGHLY contagious hemorrhagic viral disease of domestic and wild pigs.
- NO cure, NO vaccine, and NO chance
- Very hardy and resilient virus
- ONLY affects members of the pig family, NOT HUMANS.
- Spreads through ingestion of contaminated pork products and direct contact with infected animal or bodily fluids, as well as indirect contact with contaminated objects (trailers, equipment, clothing/footwear).
















Never Before Seen Decline in Chinese Production














The U.S. Isn't The Only One Selling Pork To China

Pork and Variety Meat Exports to China/HK





This Will NOT Be A 1:1 Ratio of Hog to Feed Reduction


- Given the size of China's hog herd, hog feed dominated in the feed market before ASF.
- Other feed species picked up slack as producers look to capture animal protein demand, resulting in smaller overall feed demand decline than in number of pigs decline.
- Structure of China's hog industry also muted decline somewhat, the loss of "backyard" style operations does not translate to direct feed loss.




Impacts to Other Proteins

- Dairy
 - Weaned pigs often placed on starter feed with significant % of dried whey permeate.
- Poultry
 - Likely to see biggest benefits in the short term.
 - Cheaper than pork and beef, characteristics, 6 weeks to grow a bird
- Beef
 - Expected to benefit as well, potentially to a slower extent
 - More expensive protein, might be harder cultural shift

Recovery is Happening Quicker Than Most Thought




- Many in industry say it could be a while before FULLY under control, but they can still increase herd size and production more quickly than most thought.
- Herd may never return to numbers it was, but due to structure of industry changing, will produce more pork than before because of shift to larger commercial operations. Good news for long term feed demand.

- Smuggling in tainted meat
- Bulk Feed Ingredients

Summary

- Most of the current restocking has been driven by large scale commercial producers. China's pork industry undergoing a restructuring as small producers elect not to restock.
- Shifting of Chinese consumer's protein consumption in the short term.
- ASF is endemic...could easily take a while to fully get under control. However, countries can adapt to live with it. Not just a China problem, impacting entire region.
- U.S. Pork, Beef, and Poultry producers could stand to profit, but trade tensions holding them back.
- Feed Demand faced a short-term loss, but potentially long-term gain depending on restructuring of Chinese hog industry.
